



India's largest Martial Arts Fest to be held at Lavasa

Martial art practitioners from 6 countries and 14 Indian states to display their exemplary skills

Mumbai, April 14, 2014: Lavasa, the planned hill city will play host to India's largest Martial Arts fest from 18th to 20th April 2014. Leading Indian and international exponents of various martial art forms like Chitah Yajnesh Shetty (President of Chitah JKD Global Sports Federation & Empty Hand Combat India and instructor to over 200 Bollywood and Hollywood stars), Sifu Cosmo Zimik ((Director of Empty Hand Warrior – Juveniles Mentor Program, USA and Coach For Olympic Games, renowned trainer of Law Enforcement agencies, Military personnel etc) will lead a team of martial art instructors from 6 countries and 14 Indian states.
